## International Admission Fees and Procedure

JK to Grade 8 - \$12,000

Grade 9 - \$13,000

Grade 10 - \$14,000

Grade 11 - \$15,000

Grade 12 - \$16,000

Processing Fee - \$500

## International Admission Process

Tuition fees for international students must be paid in full upon time of acceptance and are non-refundable. International students follow the following four-stage admission procedure:

### *Stage 1*

- School transcripts
- Report cards (from the last academic year)
- Two reference letters (one from a school official and one personal)
- A one-page personal statement written by the student
- An admission test of mailed to the student for completion

### *Stage 2: SKYPE Interview*

After all records, references, and test results are received, a formal Skype interview will be scheduled during which the student's goals, concerns, and test performance will all be discussed. The student will be notified of his or her acceptance within 24 hours after the interview.

### *Stage 3*

Upon acceptance, the application form is to be completed and submitted to the Admissions Office. At this time, tuition fees must also be paid in full in CAD.

### *Stage 4*

In the event that the student is granted a VISA and study permit by Canadian authorities, the tuition fee becomes non-refundable and he or she may proceed to *Stage 5*. If, however, the student fails to receive proper documentation to study in Canada, the tuition fees will be refunded with the exception of the processing fee in CAD.

### *Stage 5*

Prior to the beginning of classes, the following documentation must be received from the newly admitted student:

- Student's passport (will be returned after being photocopied)
- Student's VISA (will be returned after being photocopied)
- Up-to-date immunization records
- "Declaration of Legal Guardianship" (if the parent is not the guardian)
- Name and address of Canadian residence
